The purpose of the report is to provide preservation recommendations according to proper Arboriculture practices. Upon review plans may require amending to ensure trees are adequately preserved and protected which may subsequently require revised plans.</p> <p>Note: One (1) replacement tree is required for each healthy Municipal Tree removed between 0-49cm in diameter. Two (2) replacement trees are required for each healthy Municipal Tree removed between 50cm and greater.</p>

1. Are 3 or more Private Trees over 15cm D.B.H (diameter at breast height) proposed to be removed?			
<p>If yes, a tree permit is required. Complete and submit a tree permit application form and supporting documents to 950 Burnhamthorpe Rd. West on the same day as the Site Plan Application File is submitted to the Development and Design Division.</p> <p>Note: An Arborist Report is required when a tree permit is submitted. The purpose of the report is to identify trees to be preserved and trees to be removed. Including preservation recommendations according to proper Arboriculture practices.</p>			
2. A Tree Permit will be issued when Site Plan Application is at the satisfactory phase
