

## DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

The City of Mississauga passed a new development charges by-law on June 19, 2019. The rates in this table are valid for building permits issued after July 12, 2019 and in effect until January 31, 2020, SUBJECT TO TRANSITION PROVISIONS IN NEW DC BY-LAW.

The School Boards passed new development charges by-laws in May 2019, the rates shown below are in effect on July 1, 2019.
