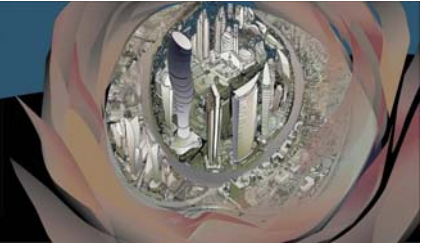


2007 MISSISSAUGA URBAN DESIGN AWARDS



Peter Kuitenbrouwer

Born to parents who met on a ship from Holland, Peter Kuitenbrouwer grew up on a farm in western Quebec. There, he went to French grade school and English high school at Lachute. After a colourful academic career at Santa Rosa Junior College in northern California and the University of New Brunswick, Peter finally settled on McGill, as it is home to Canada's only daily student newspaper.
